1st Ever Junior Visitation.



Saturday, March 6 is a day to remember here in Progreso, Honduras. We had the goal of beginning a soul winning program for the junior age children in our church (10-12 year olds). We had been anticipating the day when we could finally begin such a program to help these children learn of their responsibility to share the Gospel with others. Finally, after much preparation we began our Junior Visitation. After a training session for the 19 children who attended, we knocked on 96 doors, talked to 68 people and distributed 104 gospel tracts and invitations to our church. How exciting it is to see these young people be obedient and do their part to reach others for Christ.

The Battle Of Normandy Is Over in Honduras.

Before leaving for the States we had met a teen girl named Norma. We had spoken with her several times about the wonderful news of the Gospel, but she sheepishly rejected. Because of her hardness, my wife and I would say we were facing the "Battle of Normandy" in trying to win her to the Lord. Nevertheless, we continued to pray for her salvation. As we were traveling in the States, the Lord was working in her life. She attended other services and heard a message about the second coming of Christ, but she still refused to repent of her sins and accept Christ as her Savior. We returned and quickly noticed when we saw Norma attend one of our Wednesday night services. After church that night, we gave her a ride home in order to speak with her again about her need of salvation. Again, she rejected the Gospel and we continued to pray. The following Saturday we passed by her house once again to share with her the Gospel. This time, she humbly repented of her sins and put her faith and trust in the Lord as her personal Savior. Praise the Lord for His work in Norma's life and please pray that she will continue to grow as a new Christian.
